## **Guidelines for B.Sc. Practical Examination TEE June 2021**

For the B.Sc. programme (old scheme), the following alternative assessment methods for the evaluation of the Lab courses have been decided:

- Written examination will be held for all the lab courses.
- One question paper will be there for each Lab Course.
  The students will write their answers on the question paper itself and upon completion, hand it over to the invigilator.
- Question paper of a 4-credit course will have 25 objective type or short answer questions. Student has to answer any 20 questions. Each question will be of 2½ marks. Similarly, a 2-credit course will have 15 questions in the question paper and student has to answer any 10 questions.
- Each question will be of 2½ marks. The maximum marks for 4-credit and 2-credit courses are assigned 50 and 25 respectively.
- The time limit given to answer a 4 Credit course is 1 hour and for a 2 Credit course is 30 minutes. A gap of at least 15 minutes will be kept between any two examinations as specified in the Date sheet.
