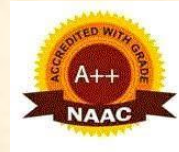

From the Desk of the Senior Regional Director



We are pleased to release the first newsletter for the period July to September 2025 showcasing the various activities organized by the IGNOU Regional Centre, Khanna. The Regional Centre is committed to provide quality education to all in the society and contribute significantly for having an inclusive education society. Effective and efficient use of technology is the strength of Regional Centre, Khanna for addressing grievances/queries of the learners and strengthening Learner Support Centres under its jurisdiction. The real challenge in the present context is to empower the youth to enable them to contribute significantly through ODL system for the betterment of society.

Major focus in this duration was on providing better learner support services through different platforms. This included conducting face to face Grievance Redressal Camps at the Regional Centre besides the Online Student Grievance Redressal sessions, which are being organized every Thursday at 4.00 p.m. through Google Meet. The Term End Examination (TEE) June 2025 for theory papers commenced w.e.f. 12th June 2025 and continued till 19th July 2025. Eleven Examination centres were established for conducting the examination at different learner support centres. During TEE June 2025, 49990 sittings of different learners were registered out of which 43545 were recorded as appeared and 6445 noted as absent. Thus, the attendance during this examination was found to be 87.10%. Term End Practical Examination along with viva voce for Internships, Projects, Dissertations etc. were also successfully completed. During this period, 40866 Assignments of different Programmes were received, out of which 35895 were evaluated. Awards of Assignments transmitted to the Student Evaluation Division (SED) till date were 34803 for Term End Examination June 2025.

Pre-admission counselling sessions (Online) were conducted by the academics of Regional Centre, as the admission process for the July 2025 session was going on. Fresh admission session commenced from 6th June 2025 while the Re-registration (RR) had already started on 15th May 2025. Induction programme was conducted for the learners of Certificate in Professional Development of Teachers (CPDT) Programme wherein teachers of Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNV) took admission in the 7th batch. Besides this, first batch of Workshop was also conducted through face-to-face mode for these teachers at National Leadership Institute (NLI), Amritsar from 8 - 12 September 2025.

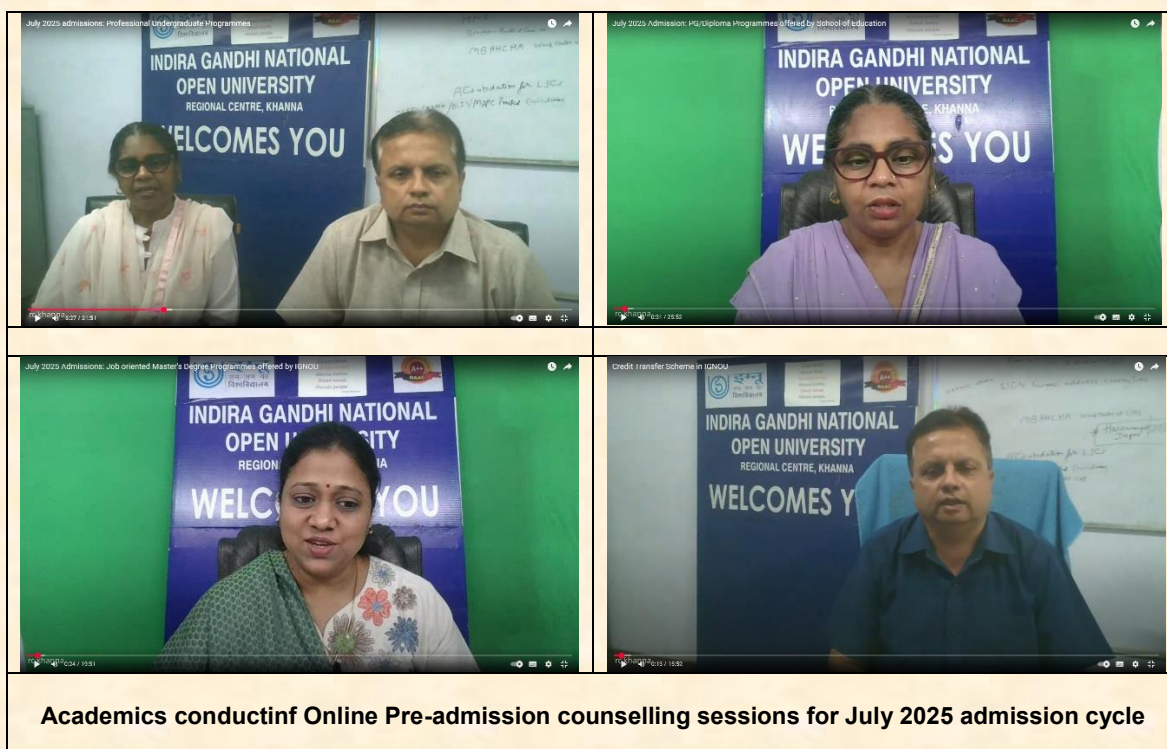

a. Pre-admission Counselling

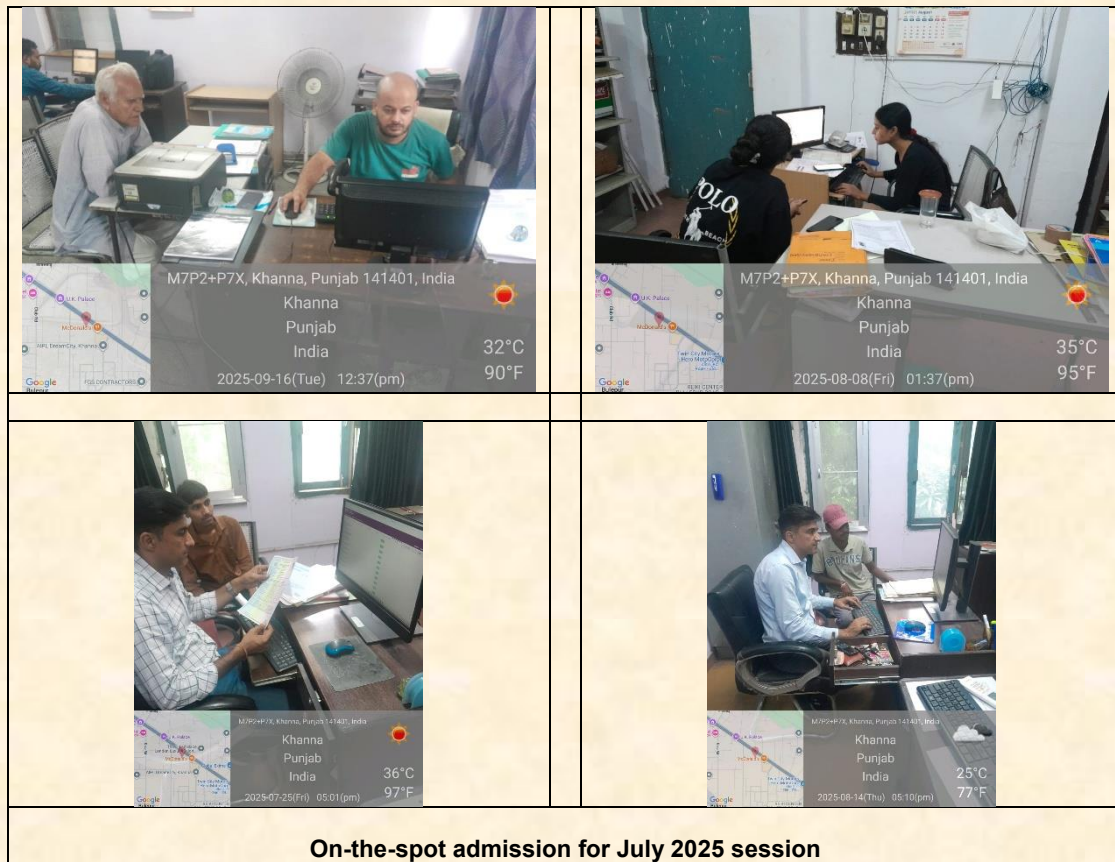

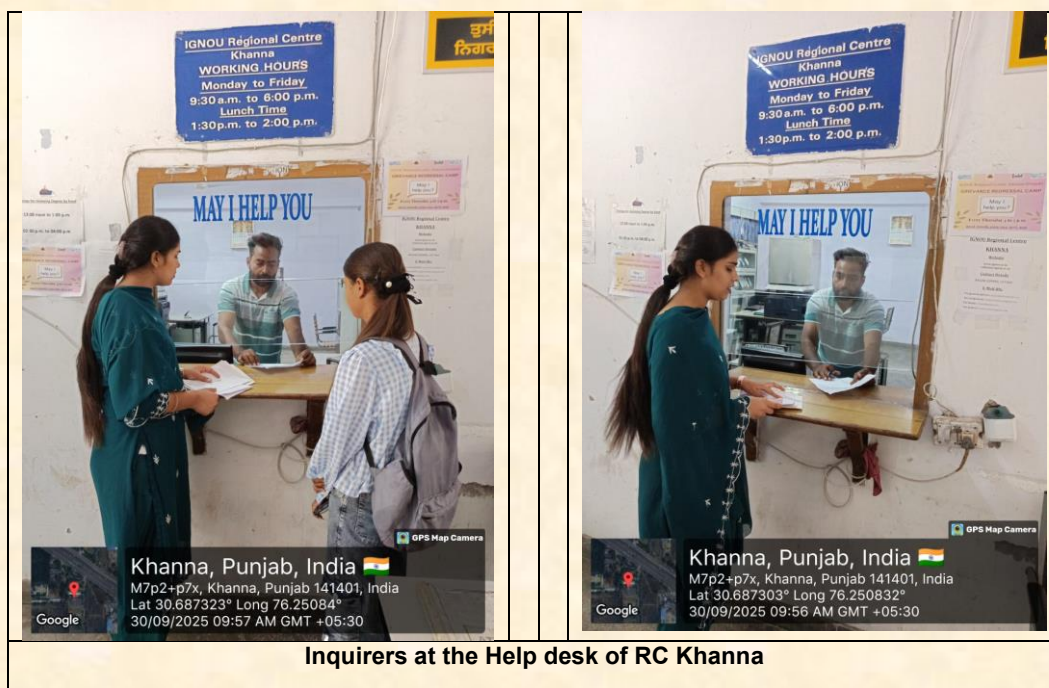
b. On-the-spot admission for the prospective learners

With the commencement of admission cycle of July 2025 session, many prospective learners were facing difficulty for creating the ABC ID as well as DEB ID. We were receiving a number of queries in this regard. To resolve the queries/problems of the learners, we decided to conduct on-the-spot admission w.e.f. 3rd July 2025. We received an encouraging response from the applicants. In this quarter, 158 application forms were filled online through the Samarth Portal by the staff of Regional Centre, Khanna thereby providing support services to the prospective learners.



c. Face to face & telephonic Guidance

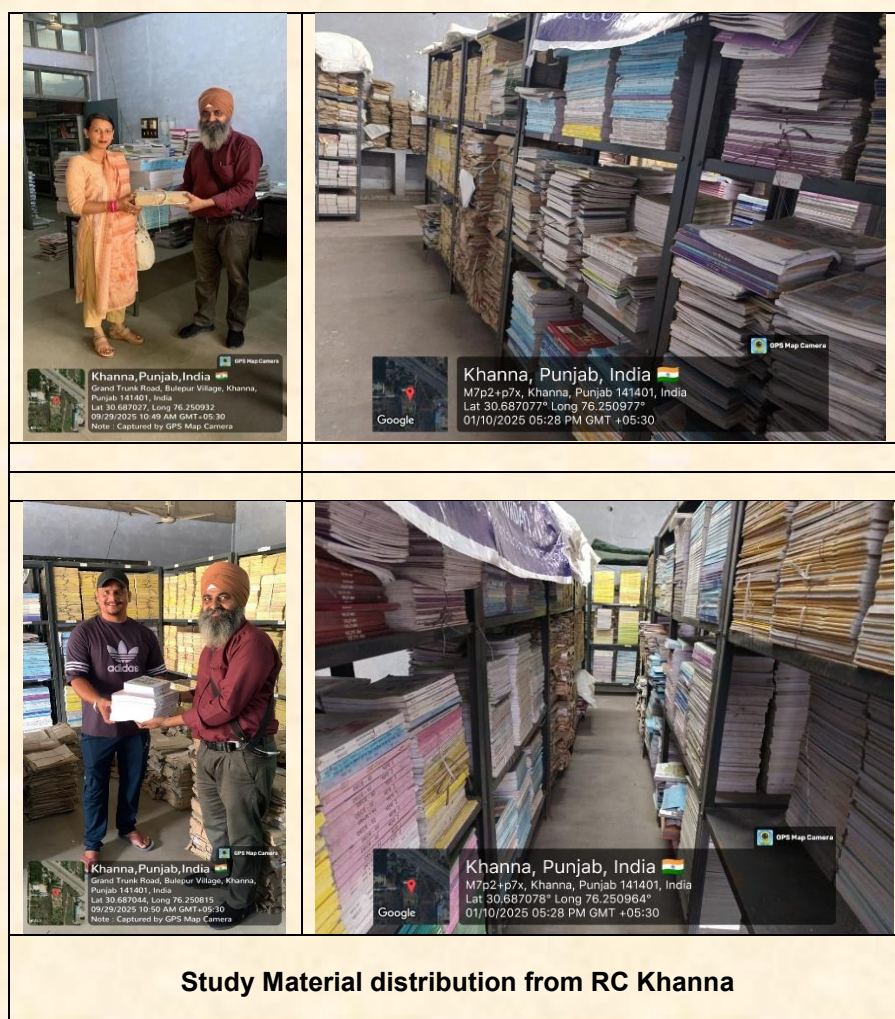

Study Material Distribution

Despatch/Handing over of the Study Material from the Warehouse of Regional Centre, Khanna

A Warehouse was established in the premises of IGNOU Regional Centre, Khanna in the year 2008-09 for keeping the IGNOU Study Material. Initially, the books were despatched to the learners through the Study Centres as well as the Regional Centre. Later on, the Warehouses of RC Chandigarh and RC Shimla were also established in the office of Regional Centre, Khanna itself and the responsibility was given to RC Khanna to despatch the study material. The distribution of Study Material was centralised after 2017 and distribution of Study Material started from the MPDD directly. In spite of this, RC Khanna has been entrusted with the responsibility of despatching the study material to the learners continuously as we receive the data for despatching the study material to the learners and also gunny bags are received continuously from IGNOU HQs. As per the data received from the Material Production & Distribution Division, IGNOU, New Delhi, during the quarter, we despatched the study material to the learners from the warehouse of RC Khanna. 96 packets of Study Material were despatched/distributed during this period.

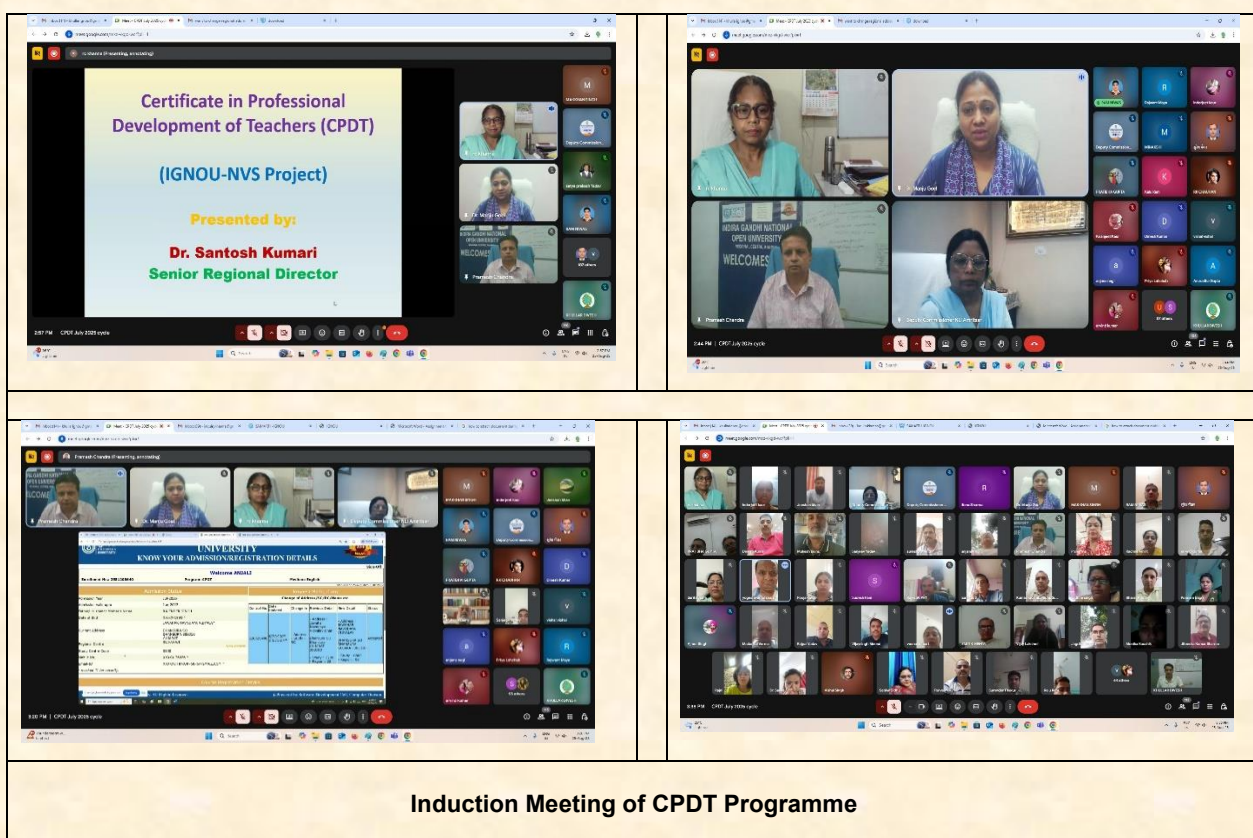

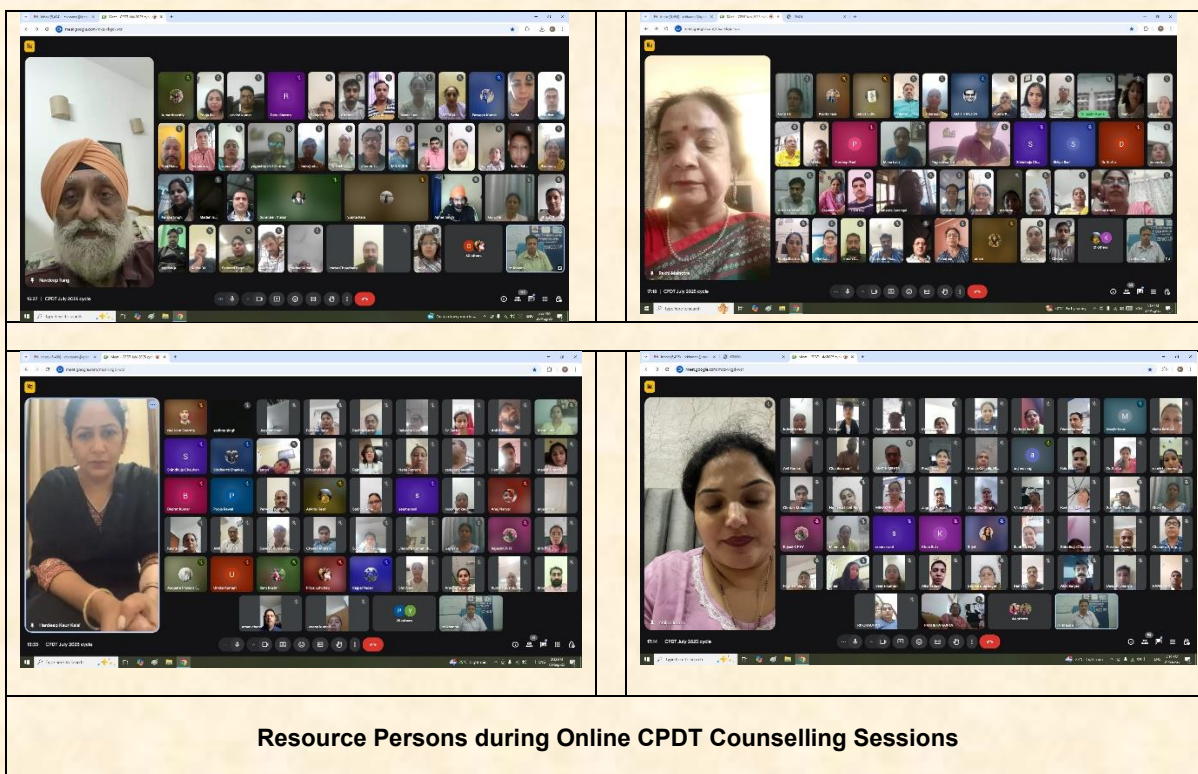
i) Online Induction Meeting of CPDT learners for July 2025 session

IGNOU Regional Centre, Khanna conducted an Online Induction Meeting on 25th August 2025 for the seventh batch of learners who have taken admission in six months Programme – Certificate in Professional Development of Teachers (CPDT). The Deputy Commissioner of National Leadership Institute (NLI), Amritsar also participated in this meeting. The learners were made aware about the theory counselling sessions, process of submission of assignments, School Based Activities, Workshop activities and Examination. 106 learners, who are teachers from Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas, participated in this Induction Meeting.

c. LIVE Channel Based Teaching

LIVE Channel Based Teaching sessions (in regional language Punjabi) started from 10th January 2022 on all working days from 1:30 – 2:30 p.m. through SWAYAMPRABHHA Channel from the studio established at IGNOU RC Khanna. The Teaching sessions are being conducted in the disciplines of Psychology, Economics, Sociology, Political Science, History, Public Administration etc. under UG Programmes.

A total of 869 Sessions have been held during the period from 10th January 2022 to 30th September 2025. However, the number of sessions conducted during this quarter. from 1st July 2025 to 30th September 2025 were 63.

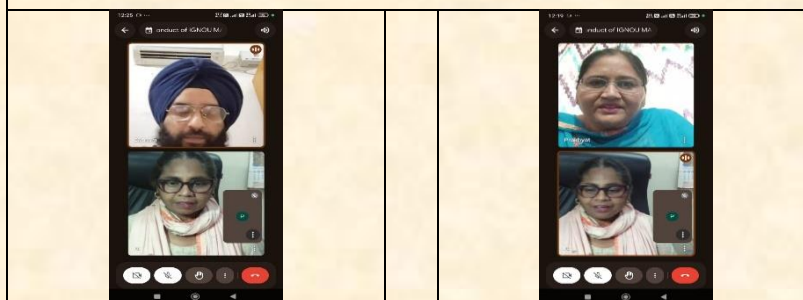

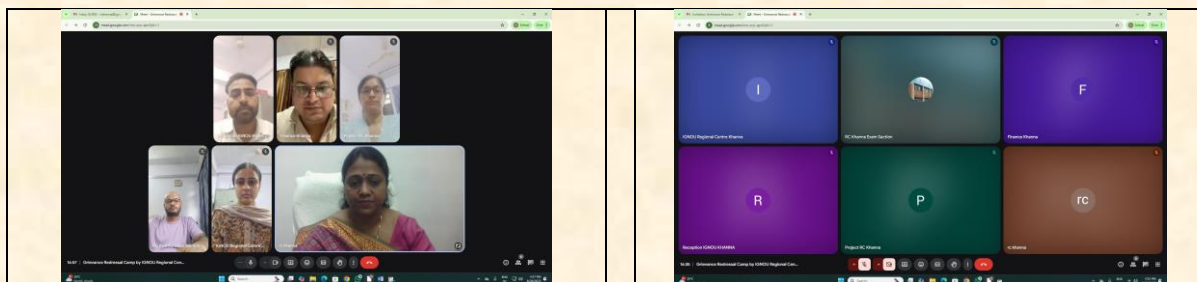
Grievance Redressal Camp on July 2025 Admission Cycle (29.08.25)



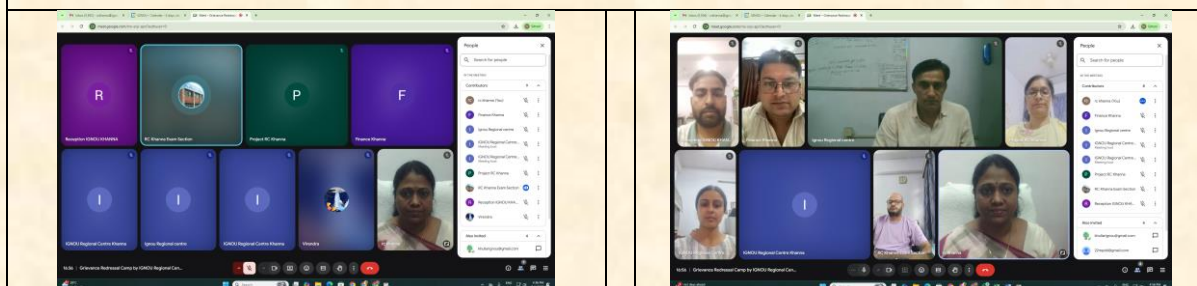

b. Grievance Redressal Camp (Online) (Weekly)

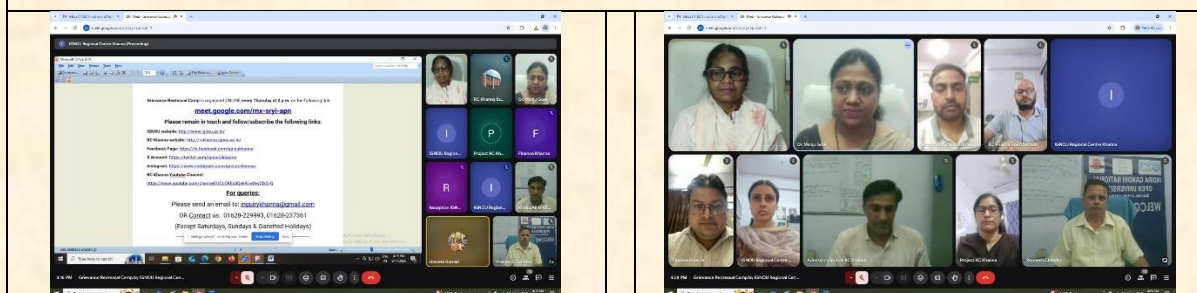

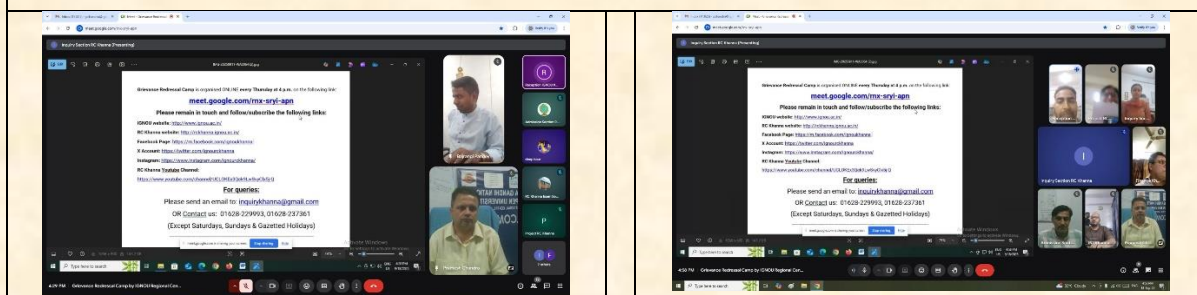
Online Grievance Redressal Camp on 28.08.2025



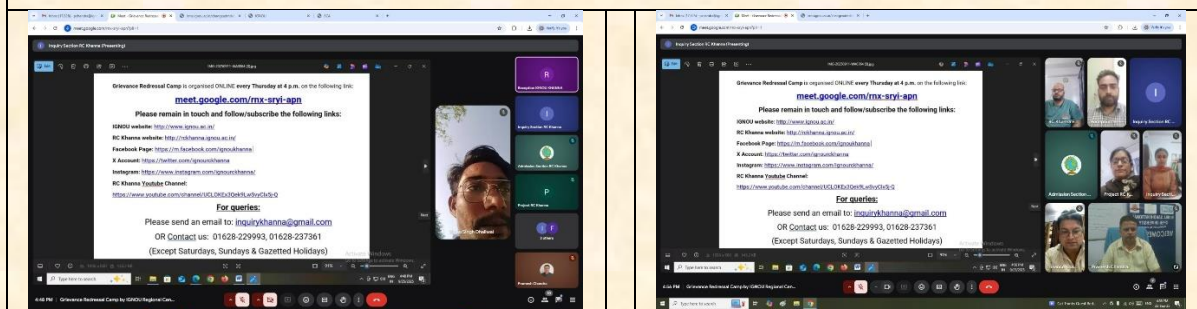
Online Grievance Redressal Camp on 04.09.2025

Admission Counselling of B.Sc. (Nursing) Programme – Jan. 2025 session (30.09.2025)

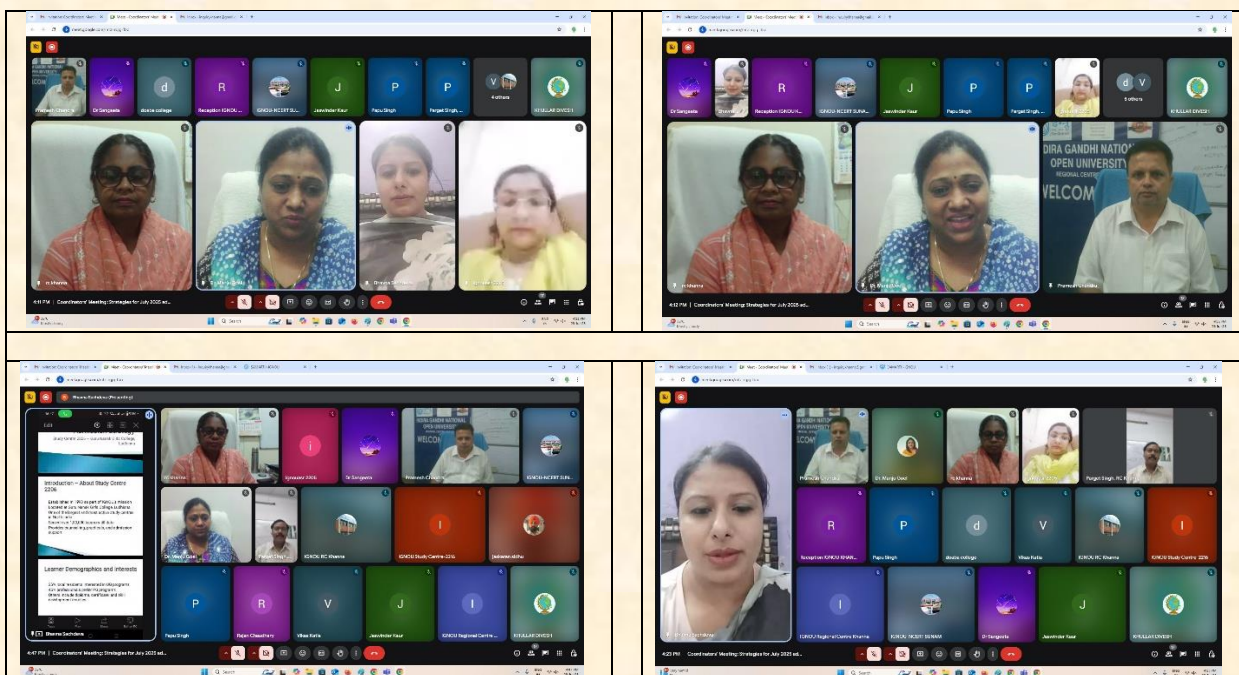

On the occasion of the celebration of 5th Anniversary of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, IGNOU Regional Centre, Khanna conducted a National Webinar on 29.07.2025. The Keynote Speaker was Prof. (Dr.) Chandra Bhushan Sharma, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Vinoba Bhave University, Hazaribag, Jharkhand.

Dr. Santosh Kumari, Sr. Regional Director welcomed the guest speaker, Coordinators, Principals, learners, academic counsellors, Staff of Regional Centre, Khanna and other RCs. She made all the participants aware on the vision of NEP 2020. The policy emphasizes on breaking down rigid boundaries between disciplines, aiming to cultivate well-rounded individuals capable of creative problem-solving, critical thinking, and innovation. She introduced the participants about the key features of the policy such as:

To sum up his talk, he emphasized that for the progress of our society, there should be a close connectivity between the knowledge economy and the labour economy.

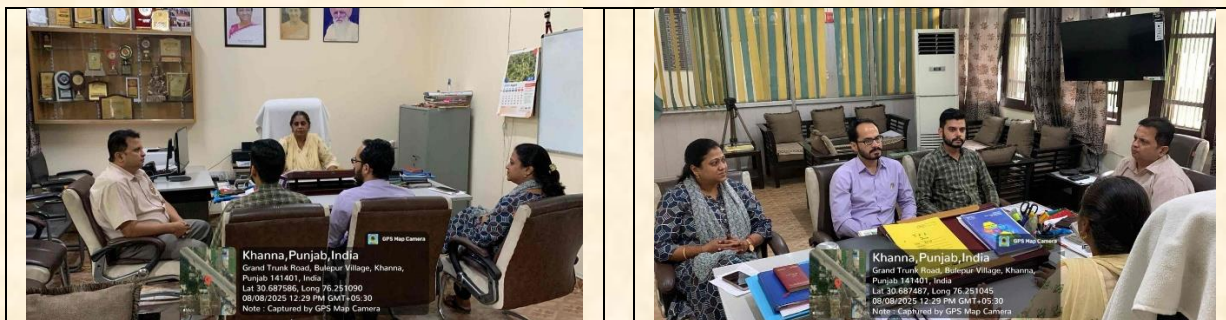

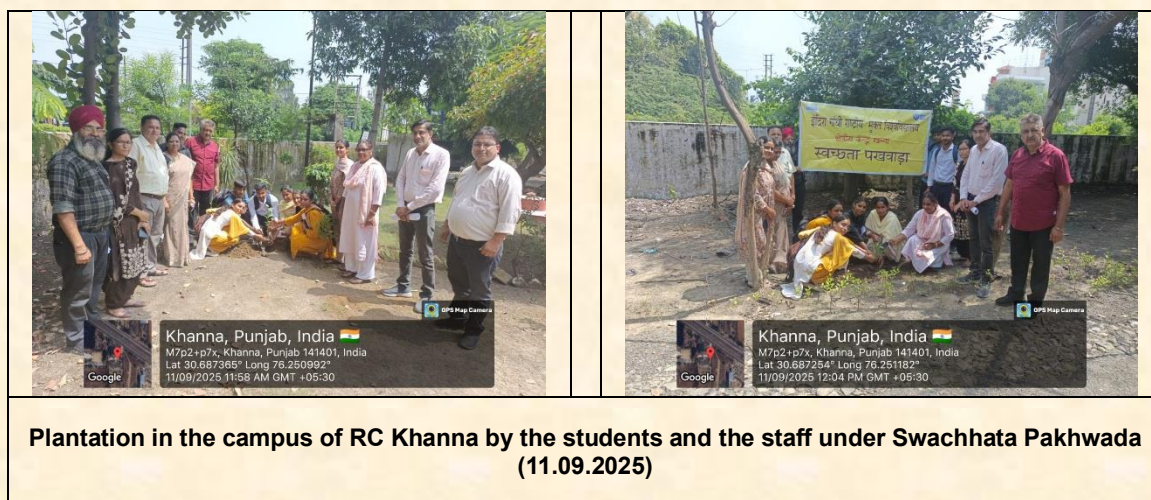
Conduct of Gram Sabha on 79th Independence Day

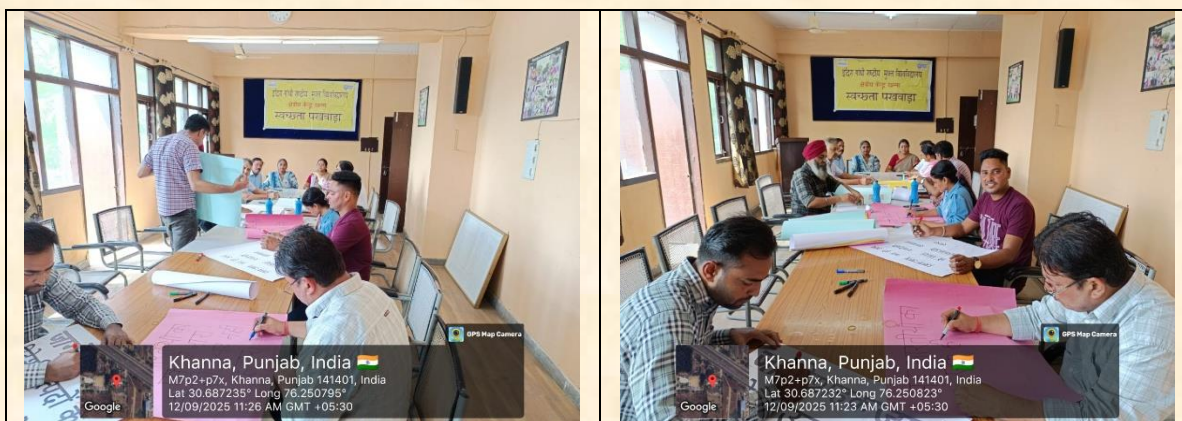


Slogan Writing/ Poster Making Competition on Swachhata Pakhwada (12th September 2025)

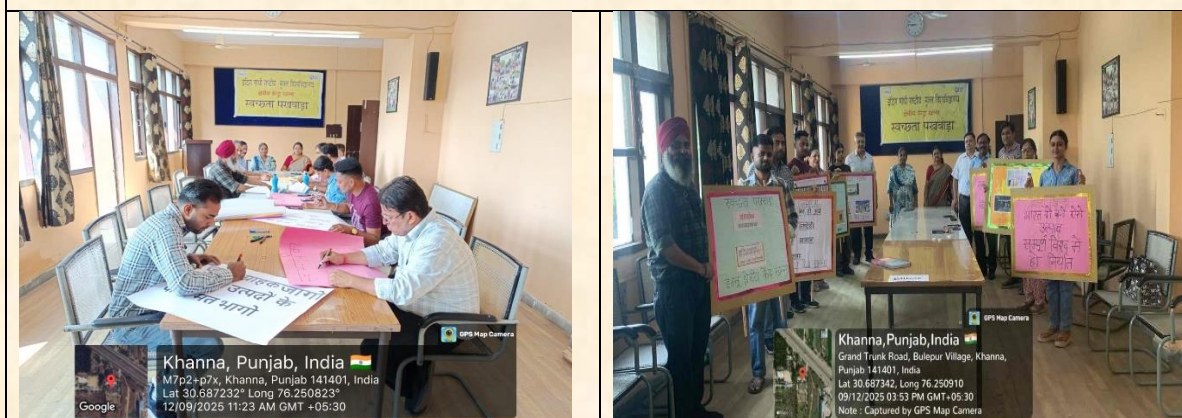

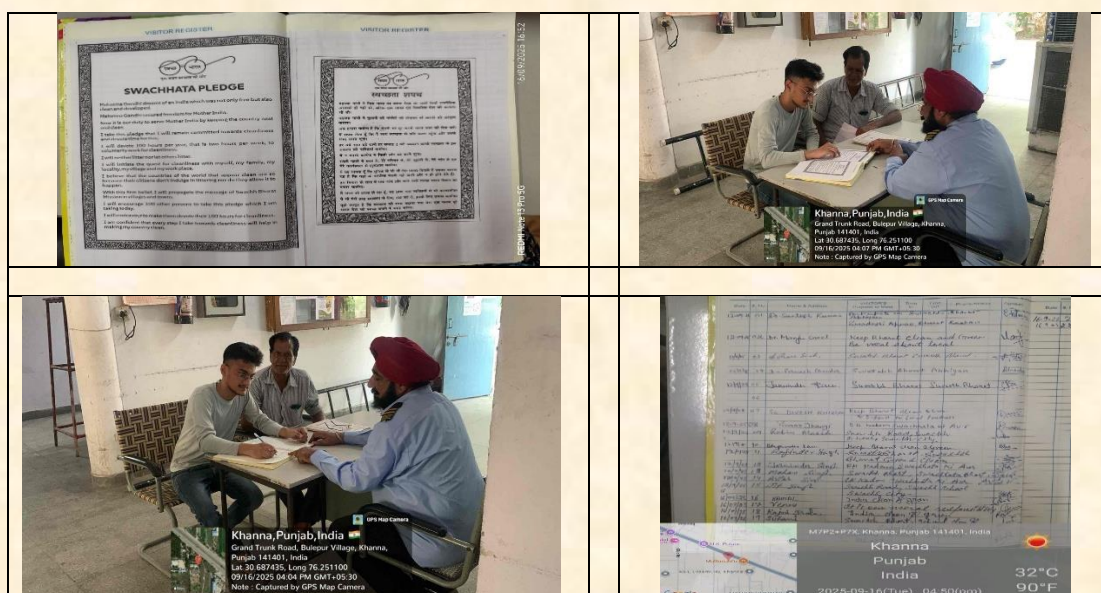
